

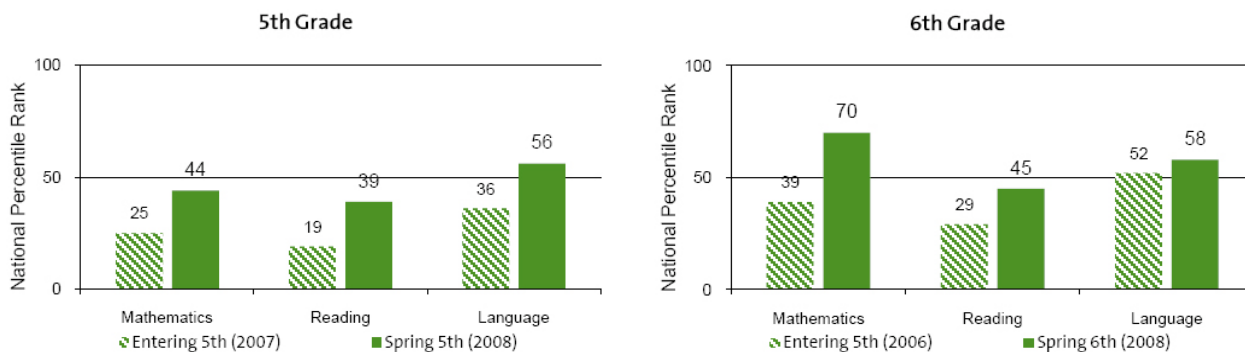
KIPP Results

KIPP LEAD College Prep Charter School Stanford Achievement Test Results 2007-2008

Early test results demonstrate the effectiveness of our program: KIPP LEAD students are making significant gains after only two years. Here are a few highlights of our academic achievement:

- Class of 2015, our fifth graders last year, jumped from the 19th to the 39th percentile in reading, from the 25th to the 44th percentile in math and from the 36th to the 56th percentile in language as measured by the Stanford-10, a nationally norm-referenced exam.
- Class of 2014, our sixth graders last year, jumped from the 29th to 45th percentile in reading, from the 39th to 70th percentile in math and from the 52nd to 58th percentile in language.

Perhaps most significant is that out of five categories given to schools in Indiana by the Indiana Department of Education, KIPP LEAD received the highest ranking of **Exemplary Progress** for the growth made with the Class of 2014.
